Our Tributo wines pay tribute to our unique terroir in Colchagua, are a tribute to a unique natural environment, a tribute to hard work, imbued with the big heart of a team, a tribute to sustainable practices and the unique quality of our wines. That and much more, is what Tributo wines represent.

These wines are single vineyard wines, specifically chosen from one block for each of the different varieties to maximize its expression, and are aged between 10 and 14 months in barrels depending on the wine, looking to deliver elegance and character under a sustainable philosophy.

Viña Caliterra and its Commitment to the Community

Our sustainable philosophy is not only evident in our vineyards, cellar, and in every area of our company, but in our social setting as well. This is reflected in an ongoing concern for our workers and our relationship with the community.

Viña Caliterra has collaborated on many sustainable initiatives in conjunction with the Municipality of Palmilla. Last year the winery donated 12 recycling points for installation in schools and social organizations around town, it helped with emergency housing for those who lost their homes in the earthquake, and actively helped rebuild them.

This relationship has grown over time, and last month Palmilla and its Mayor chose Viña Caliterra as the place to sign the agreement between the Colchagua Association of Sustainable Municipalities and the Ministry of the Environment. Signed in the presence of important members of the community and environment-related authorities, the agreement will allow the municipalities to achieve environmental certification, among other things. Events such as these are a reflection of our winery's concern and desire to see the sustainable philosophy spread beyond our limits to permeate our entire environment.
