First Vintage

Cenit represents "the highest point in the sky" [el punto más alto del cielo], our commitment to a sustainable environment and the Caliterra Estate terroir in the Colchagua Valley, where abundant sunshine, clear skies and cooling breezes set the perfect environment for crafting this silky and elegant wine. Every December twenty first the longest day of the year takes place in the southern hemisphere due to the summer solstice. Such day the sun has its cenit over our Caliterra Estate as we celebrate the bottling of the new vintage of Cenit [the Highest wine in the Caliterra sky].

"The 2005 Cenit is a blend of 60% Cavernet Sauvignon, 30% Malbec, and 10% Petit Verdot. Opaque purple colored, it has a splendid perfume of pain grille, pencil lead, violets, black currant, and black cherry. This is followed by a full-bodied, nearly opulent wine. Dense and ripe, it has gobs of black fruit flavors and enough tannin to evolve for 3-5 years."

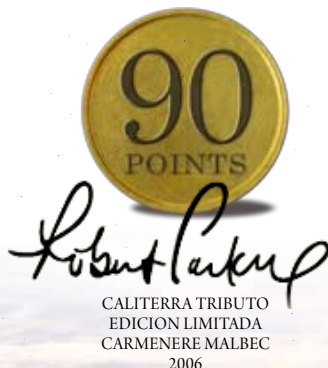

Caliterra Tributo Edicion Limitada Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon Viognier 2006

"The 2006 Tributo Edicion Limitada Shiraz (60%)- Cabernet Sauvignon (34%)- Viognier (6 %) is purple-colored with an already complex bouquet of wood smoke, cedar, spice box, floral notes, blackberry, and blueberry. Smooth textured and rich on the palate, the wine has gobs of savory, spicy black fruit flavors, excellent balance, and a lengthy, pure finish."

Caliterra Tributo Edicion Limitada Carmenere Malbec 2006

"The 2006 Tributo Edicion Limitada Carmenere (60%)- Malbec (40%) was barrel-fermented and aged for 14 months in French and American oak. It exhibits a nose of pain grille, pencil lead, spice box, black currant, and blackberry. This leads to a medium to full-bodied wine with layered fruit, savory black fruit flavors, and enough structure to evolve for 1-2 years."
